CHIEF OF POLICE VACANCY

Freer is a city located in Duval County, Texas. The City of Freer is a Type "A" Municipality.

Under the general administrative direction of the Mayor, the Chief of Police is responsible for overseeing, managing and supervising all aspects of the police department to ensure public safety, crime prevention, interaction with the community, and the enforcement of local, state, and federal laws.

The Chief of Police shall patrol the community, respond to calls for service, investigate accidents and crimes, conduct follow-up investigations of reported crimes, and respond to written and verbal inquiries and complaints from citizens, staff, City Council, other agencies and departments.

The Chief of Police must be professional, possess strong organizational skills, and have a competent knowledge of criminal, juvenile, traffic, and civil law and professional procedures. The Chief of Police shall work effectively with other departments, fellow employees, and the City Council.
