Responsibilities for Dispatcher

Duties

- Ability to pass drug and psychological testing
- Excellent conflict management skills, with the ability to remain composed under pressure.
- Effective communication skills, both verbal and written, with a keen attention to detail.
- Ability to work flexible hours, including nights, weekends, and holidays as required.
