The Civil Service Commission, City of Duncanville, invites qualified persons to take the examination for Police Officer. The examination will be held on February 10, 2024, at 8:00 a.m. at 206 James Collins Blvd, Duncanville, Texas 75116. A map is attached below.

Registration for the exam will begin at 7:00 a.m. and the doors will be locked at 8:00 a.m.

QUALIFIED APPLICANT

- Must be a minimum of 20 1/2 years of age and shall not have reached their 45th birthday.
- Must possess a high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate.
- Must possess a valid Texas driver's license (upon employment) and have a good driving record.
- Must not have been convicted of a felony at any time or a Class B misdemeanor or above in the last 10 years.
- Must be a United States citizen.
- Must have an honorable discharge from the Armed Forces, if applicable.
- Must have vision correctable to 20/20.

Must be able to pass the following:

Physical Performance Test, Background Investigation, Oral Boards, Physical Examination by Physician, Polygraph and Psychological Tests

Starting Salary is \$67,000.00 for the first year.

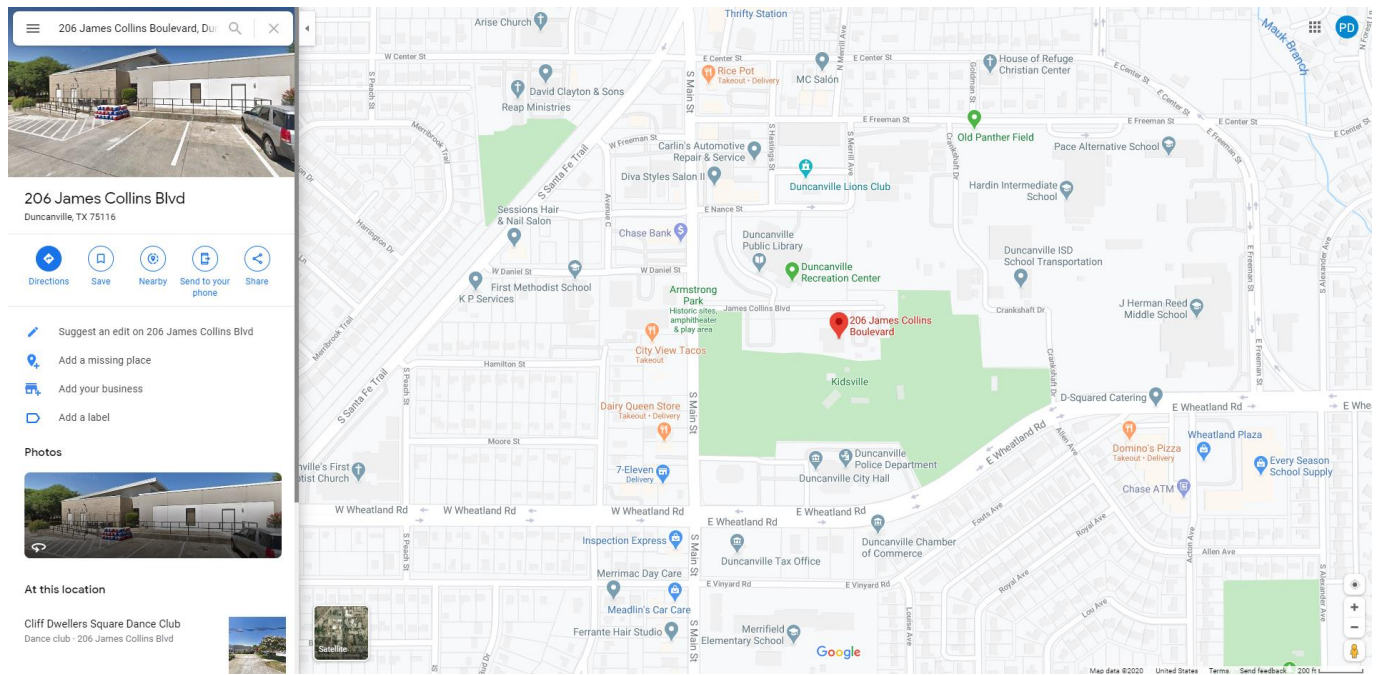

Physical Performance Testing

Physical performance testing will be conducted following the completion of the Civil Service Exam on February 10, 2024. Applicant's passing the test will report to the Duncanville Police Department to complete this segment of the hiring process. The time to report will be announced after the completion of the Civil Service Test. Applicants testing will need to make sure that they bring with them, or have immediately available, appropriate clothing to complete the Physical Performance Test.

1. Tennis Shoes
2. Shorts or Warm-up type pants
3. T-shirt or Sweat shirt
4. Water

The Physical Performance Test consists of the 2,000-meter row test on a Concept 2 Rower.

If a large number of applicants pass the Civil Service Exam, the number of applicants tested on the Physical Performance Course may be limited to the first 20. The remaining applicants will test on a later date, as needed.

Applicants passing both the written exam and the physical performance testing will then complete preliminary background questionnaires.

Every Applicant should plan to spend up to 8 hours to complete all activities.

APPLICANT INFORMATION ON PHYSICAL PERFORMANCE TEST**

As part of the selection standards for appointment to the Duncanville Police Department, you will be required to pass a Physical Performance Test, provided you have met all prior requirements. The following information is provided for your assistance.

If you have any physical condition which, in the opinion of the Test Administrator, could present a greater than normal possibility of injury, you may be required to obtain a physician's statement to document your suitability for testing.

Gym type clothing may be worn. Athletic type shoes must be worn.

As part of the selection standards for appointment to the Duncanville Police Department, you will be required to pass a Physical Performance Test, provided you have met all prior requirements. The Duncanville Police Department utilizes the 2000-meter row test.

To successfully pass the Concept 2 Rower test, an applicant is required to complete the 2,000-meter row and achieve a minimum score of 25%, with the difficulty level set to "5". The passing score is determined based on your gender, age and weight. All row tests will be administered by a certified tester. To determine your minimum standard for a passing 25%, visit the [Texas Department of Public Safety website](#) (Hold Control and Select Link) and follow the steps below:

- select your gender and age range then type in your weight
- under the "Desired Results" section, type in "25"
- click "Calculate"
- you must achieve that time or faster to pass the Concept 2 Rower test.
