TCOLE Arrests Chief of Indian Lake Police Department

CAMERON COUNTY, TX- On Wednesday, Indian Lake Police Department Chief John Chambers was indicted by a Cameron County grand jury on 14 counts of tampering with a government record, a state jail felony. Chambers' indictment was the result of a multi-agency investigation by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE), the Cameron County District Attorney's Office and the Texas Department of Public Safety.

Chambers was subsequently arrested by investigators from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement and the Cameron County District Attorney's Office and booked into the Cameron County jail. Chambers faces up to two years in prison for each count. Upon conviction, TCOLE will move to revoke Chambers' peace officer license.
