Minimum Qualifications include:

- U.S. Citizen;
- High School Diploma or have a high school equivalency certificate/GED;
- At least 21 years of age at the time of licensing;
- Valid Texas driver's license with good driving record at the time of hire;
- Good moral character, stable employment record and no history of any conduct which may affect suitability for law enforcement work;
- If applicable, military service discharge must be under honorable conditions as stipulated on DD-214 form;
- Applicant must not have engaged in, received deferred adjudication or pre-trial diversion, or been convicted of: conduct that constitutes a Class A Misdemeanor under the Penal Code or equivalent under federal law, to include the Uniform Code of Military Justice, or have received a Class B Misdemeanor within the past **10** years;
- Applicant must not have engaged in, received deferred adjudication or pre-trial diversion, or been convicted of DWI/BWI/FWI/DUI within the past **5** years;
- See other disqualifiers on the posting regarding drug use and/or tattoos/body art/modification.
