The Patrol Sergeant is the first level of supervision in the police department chain of command. Patrol Sergeants are expected to be familiar with the duties and responsibilities of the sworn and non-sworn personnel with whom they work.

GENERAL STATEMENT OF THE POSITION

Performs duties involving the first-line supervision of Patrol Officers and civilian employees involved in public protection, law enforcement, and criminal investigation work. Sergeants are primarily responsible for supervising the patrol of residential, commercial and greenspace areas, as well as performing Patrol Officer duties. Performs daily duties within the community-oriented policing philosophy.

MINIMUM EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE

Three years of current experience as a first line police supervisor with a law enforcement agency of comparable or larger size.
