

MINUTES – QUARTERLY MEETING

Agenda item #1, Call to order

Presiding Officer Hall called the meeting to order and asked for a reading of the line of duty deaths. Carnecia Penson read the following names:

Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office

Deputy John Norsworthy

January 4, 2011

On December 27, 2010, Deputy Norsworthy was en route to backup another officer when his patrol car left the roadway and struck a tree. Deputy Norsworthy was trapped in his vehicle for almost an hour before rescue crews could free him. He succumbed to his injuries on January 4.

Survivors: Wife and 2 children

Dallas Police Department

Police Officer Kevin P. Marceau

January 14, 2011

Officer Marceau died as the result of injuries sustained on November 13, 1996, when he was struck by a vehicle while chasing a hit-and-run suspect. Officer Marceau was in a coma for several weeks, underwent several surgeries, and remained in a wheelchair, unable to communicate until passing away on January 14.

Survivors: Son, parents, and four siblings

U.S. Department of Homeland Security

Immigration and Customs Enforcement

Special Agent Jaime J. Zapata

February 15, 2011

Special Agent Zapata, from the Laredo, Texas office was traveling between Mexico City and Monterrey when he and his partner were forced off the road by 10 members of a Mexican drug cartel. The cartel members opened fire on them, fatally wounding Agent Zapata.

Survivors: Parents and four brothers

San Antonio Police Department

Police Officer Stephanie Brown

March 15, 2011

Officer Brown was killed in an early morning crash while en route to a call. As she responded to the call, a man driving the wrong way struck her patrol car head-on.

Survivors: One-year old daughter and her father

Smith County Sheriff's Office

Deputy Robert Britton

March 28, 2011

Deputy Britton responded to the scene where a vehicle had struck and injured a cow. As he directed traffic around the animal, it charged him and knocked him into the air, landing on his head. Deputy Britton suffered severe head injuries and succumbed four days later.

Survivors: Two children

Bowie County Sheriff's Office

Deputy Sherri Jones

April 18, 2011

Deputy Jones was shot and killed in the basement of the Bowie County Courthouse while preparing to transport a prisoner. The prisoner overpowered and fatally shot her.

Johnson County Sheriff's Office

Deputy Clifton Taylor

April 23, 2011

Deputy Taylor was shot and killed after he and other deputies responded to a domestic disturbance.

He is survived by his fiancé.

Texas Department of Criminal Justice

Corrections Officer Craig A. Orrell

May 12, 2011

Corrections Officer Orrell suffered a fatal heart attack while jogging during an annual physical fitness test.

Bexar County Sheriff's Office

Sgt. Kenneth Vann

May 28, 2011

Sgt Vann was responding to a non-emergency call. He stopped at a red light when a car pulled up next to his patrol car and, without warning, the occupants immediately opened fire. Sgt. Vann succumbed to his wounds before arriving at a local hospital. The other vehicle fled the scene and the suspect(s) remain at large. He is survived by his wife, also a Bexar County Sheriff's Officer, and his three children.

Houston Police Department

Police Officer Kevin Will

May 29, 2011

Officer Will was struck and killed by a drunk driver as he interviewed a witness to a hit-and-run accident. The drunk driver drove around barriers and emergency vehicles that were blocking the closed freeway. Seeing the vehicle approach, Officer Will warned the witness to jump out of the way. The citizen was able to jump to safety moments before Officer Will was struck and killed. Officer Will is survived by his expectant wife and two children.

Director Vickers gave the invocation. It was determined by roll call that all members of the Commission were present.

Agenda item #2, Minutes of the March 2011 meeting

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 3, 2011, work session and Commissioner Richardson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 3, 2011, quarterly meeting and Commissioner Oakley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #3 Presiding Officer's Report

This agenda item was covered during the work session.

Agenda item #4, Executive Director's Report

This agenda item was covered during the work session.

Agenda item #5

- a. Psychological exam committee
Commissioner Griffith made a motion for staff to bring this item back as a proposed order. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.
- b. Definition of minimum background investigation and mitigating circumstances
Commissioner Griffith made a motion for staff to bring each of these items back as proposed orders. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.

Agenda item #6

- a. Last Chance Agreement
Commissioner Griffith clarified that if this is voted to return as a proposed order, staff will include policy for implementation. Executive Director Braaten confirmed this. Commissioner Griffith made a motion to bring the Last Chance Agreement back as a proposed order. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- b. Administrative penalty schedule
Commissioner Griffith made a motion to bring the revised administrative penalty schedule back as a proposed order. Commissioner Hollingsworth seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- c. Commission meeting dates, location, and hotel for 2012
Commissioner Oakley suggested that the work session agenda be combined with the quarterly meeting agenda for a single agenda of the quarterly meeting in order to be more efficient. Commissioner Lovejoy explained that during the last Commission strategic planning session, it was decided that having two agendas allowed the Commission time to obtain additional information, if necessary, after the work session and before voting on an item at the quarterly meeting.

Commissioner Oakley made a motion to combine the work shop agenda with the quarterly meeting agenda, having an agenda of the quarterly meeting. Presiding Officer Hall suggested having a Commission strategic planning meeting in December and discussing the agendas at that meeting. After further discussion, Commissioner Oakley pulled back his motion, but would like for the Commission to consider this idea.

Presiding Officer Hall directed Executive Director Braaten to plan a strategic planning meeting for the Commission to coincide with the December meeting, as well as consider plans to conduct strategic planning workshops around the state. Executive Director Braaten reminded the Commission that tabling a motion delays a decision for 3 months as the Commission only meets quarterly. Commissioner Oakley clarified his position that a motion not be tabled, but postponed so that additional information may be gathered and a decision made at the same meeting. Commissioner Pennington agreed with Commissioner Oakley and asked that staff return to the next meeting with a summary of pros and cons on a one-agenda meeting. Commissioner Pennington asked that meetings not be scheduled the week before or the week of March 6, primary elections, April 12, run-off elections, and November 6, general elections. Commissioner Griffith made a motion to direct staff to set the dates

based on availability of the facilities. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #7, Missouri City Police Department contractual training provider application

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to approve the application of the Missouri City Police Department to be a contractual training provider. Commissioner Oakley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #8, Pearland Police Department contractual training provider application

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to approve the application of the Pearland Police Department to be a contractual training provider. Commissioner Richardson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #9, San Juan Police Department contractual training provider application

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to approve the application of the San Juan Police Department to be a contractual training provider. Commissioner Hollingsworth seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #10, DSI Training Center contractual training provider application

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to not approve the application of DSI Training Center to be a contractual training provider. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. The motion passed with Commissioner Hollingsworth sustaining.

Agenda item #11, Request for Waiver of Rules 215.15 and 217.1 for Barclay Vose and the Hunt County Sheriff's Office

Commissioner Griffith made a motion to approve the request for waiver of TCLEOSE rules 215.15 Enrollment Standards and 217.1 Minimum Standards for Initial Licensure for Barclay Vose and the Hunt County Sheriff's Office. Commissioner Richardson seconded the motion. Commissioner Villescas questioned if Mr. Vose could continue in the academy he is currently enrolled in. Commissioner Griffith amended his motion to include that Mr. Vose be allowed to continue in the academy that he is currently enrolled in. Commissioner Richardson seconded the amendment. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #12, Request for Waiver of Rules 215.15 and 217.1 for Justin Bulls and the Coryell County Sheriff's Office

Commissioner Oakley made a motion to approve agenda item 12. Commissioner Lovejoy seconded the motion. Commissioner Oakley expanded on his motion to include reinstating his license. Director Davis asked for clarification by stating that we are to resend the cancellation letter and apply to reinstate his license. Commissioner Oakley added to his motion to resend the cancellation letter. Director Davis further clarified that we will accept his academy time and test scores. Commissioner Lovejoy stated his seconding of the motion covers the additions to the original motion. Commissioner Hollingsworth asked what Mr. Bulls will need to do to keep his license, will he have to go back through training? Executive Director Braaten said he will have to reinstate his license if there is any void in any training during this time, and we have traditionally removed service time as it was not obtained in the proper manner. Presiding Officer Hall indicated he believed this was fair as he did not have that much time and we are giving his license back. Executive Director Braaten said we will leave it the way it is. The motion passed unanimously.
