Participants must be pre-approved and registered through the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE).

This will be a physically and mentally intense seven (7) days of training.

Participants should be in descent health to participate in physical scenarios which involve moving through hallways and climbing stairs. The following is a list of equipment each participant will need to bring to class.

1. Notebook and Pen
2. A semi-automatic pistol
3. 700 rounds of ammunition for the pistol
4. At least three pistol magazines (two okay, but three preferable)
5. At least one type of holster for pistol that can be concealed
6. A gun cleaning kit
7. Eye and ear protection for firearms training
8. Comfortable clothing (jeans or tactical pants, loose shirt, comfortable shoes). Be sure to dress for the weather conditions. Recommend a jacket or baggy shirt for concealing weapon.
9. Personal water bottle/water

School Marshal Course Curriculum

1. History/Authority of School Marshals & Developing School Safety Plans
2. School Marshal Use of Force and Force Options
3. Specialized Firearms Training (Far above the standards of a CHL Course)
4. Introduction to Civilian/School Marshal Active Shooter Response
5. Reality Based Training Scenarios to Active Shooter Incidents

Note: On the first day of class participants will be required to shoot and pass the Concealed Handgun License (CHL) qualification course of fire. See the next page for CHL course of fire.

*It is **highly recommended** participants practice with their handgun prior to coming to training. The specialized firearms training on Day 2 and Day 3 is **not** a beginner's course on shooting.*



Texas CHL Proficiency Demonstration Course of Fire

Must score a 70% or higher to pass

Total of 50 Rounds of Ammo

1. 20 Rounds from 3 yards

- a. 5 rounds in a “one shot exercise” – 2 seconds for each shot
- b. 10 rounds in a “two shot exercise” – 3 seconds for each two shot sequence
- c. 5 rounds in 10 seconds

2. 20 Rounds from 7 yards

- a. 5 rounds in 10 seconds
- b. 5 rounds fired in 2 stages
 - i. 2 rounds in 4 seconds
 - ii. 3 rounds in 6 seconds
- c. 5 rounds in a “one shot exercise” – 3 seconds allowed for each shot
- d. 5 rounds in 15 seconds

3. 10 Rounds from 15 yards

- a. 5 rounds fired in 2 stages
 - i. 2 rounds in 6 seconds
 - ii. 3 rounds in 9 seconds
- b. 5 Rounds in 15 seconds
