EXAM ANNOUNCEMENT

The Galena Park Police Department is having a Civil Service examination on Saturday, January 30, 2021, at 9:00 am. The exam will be held at the Alvin D. Baggett Community Center, 1302 Keene Street, Galena Park, Texas. Prospective applicants must register for the exam in advance at the Galena Park Police Department, 2207 Clinton Drive, Galena Park, Texas.

The registration deadline is Friday, January 15, 2021, at 5:00 pm.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Prospective applicants must be a U.S. citizen, between 21 and 44 years of age, possess a high school diploma or G.E.D., be of the highest moral character, possess social adaptability to deal with all kinds of people, be of a manner and bearing suitable for police work, and must pass a background check, physical and psychological examinations, and meet all other TCOLE requirements to be licensed as a peace officer.

Prospective applicants, if not already a certified Texas peace officer, must be certified by TCOLE within 30 days of the exam date.

BENEFITS

Our benefits package includes: 100% paid health insurance for the employee (approximately 90% employer contribution for dependents); Texas Municipal Retirement System 7% - matched 2:1; TCOLE certificate pay; 26 paid vacation days and 15 paid sick days annually after successful completion of the probationary period.
