### **REQUIREMENTS**

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Possess a High School Diploma or equivalent
- Possess a valid state driver's license
- Possess Peace Officer TCOLE license
- Ability to work various shifts, weekends, and holidays
- Ability to walk, run, climb, or crawl in the pursuit of suspects; to work outdoors in inclement weather and extreme temperatures.
- Candidates will be expected to participate in and pass a medical examination including drug testing.
- Live within Gray County or within 20 air miles of GCSO to participate in take home car program.

### **BENEFITS & PERKS:**

- Longevity Pay after completion of four years of service
- 40 hours of vacation at 6 months, and 40 more hours at 12 months
- Sick leave accrual starting in the first month.
- Holidays as designated by the Commissioner's Court.
