- Thirty (30) college semester hours from an accredited college or university; **OR** a current Texas licensed Peace Officer; **OR** two (2) years of active duty experience in the U.S. military service with an Honorable discharge annotated on the applicant’s military DD-214 form; **OR** must possess a minimum of a Basic Jailer Proficiency Certificate recognized from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE)
