## Curriculum covered:

- History and authority of the School Marshal.
- Strategies for preventing school shootings and for securing the safety of potential victims of school shootings.
- Use of Force and Force Options for School Marshals.
- Provide a working knowledge of the weapons to be used.
- Introduce the school marshal to effective law enforcement strategies and techniques.
- Participate in safe, reality-based training scenarios replicating the situational environment school marshals will have to operate in.

The course is mentally and physically demanding, so students should be prepared for long training days!
