

The City of Ore City, Texas Police Department is accepting applications for two police officers. Applicants must be at least 21 years of age, and must possess a Texas peace officer license issued by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement. Ore City is located on U.S. Hwy. 259, 21 miles north of Longview, Texas in Upshur County in N.E. Texas.

Applicants must have a stable work record and be able to pass an extensive background investigation.

Duties include, but are not limited to patrol, prevention and suppression of crime, traffic law enforcement, motor vehicle crash investigation, answering calls for police service, criminal investigation, enforcement of city ordinances, state, and federal laws, report writing, arresting offenders, and testifying in court.
