School Resource Officer (SRO)

Description:

The Bruceville-Eddy Police Department in partnership with Bruceville-Eddy ISD established a School Resource Program in 2022 and is currently accepting applications for a School Resource Officer (SRO) for the 2022-2023 school year. Pay Depends on Qualifications (Starting \$32,500/yr - \$35,000/yr).

Requirements:

- Must be at least 21 years of age.
 - **Must hold a current Texas Peace Officer license issued by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE).**
 - Have a high school diploma or GED.
 - Must hold a valid Texas Driver's License with acceptable driving record.
 - Must be physically fit to perform the functions of a patrol officer.

 - The ability to work well with children from K-12 levels and split time between four (Elementary, Intermediate, Jr High, and High School) campuses.
 - Patrol School Zones during the week and work routine patrol when school is not in session during the summer, school holidays, and / or as needed by the Department.
 - Work with Bruceville-Eddy ISD personnel to establish and implement Standard Response Protocol to Emergency Situations.
 - Offer verbal instruction to students regarding Standard Response Protocols and Interaction with Law Enforcement Classes.
 - SRO Certification is preferred. Applicants who are not currently certified, will be required to gain certification prior as soon as possible.
 - Some travel may be required for off campus activities as determined by Bruceville-Eddy ISD.
 - The ability to work or coordinate security for afterhours events may be required as requested by Bruceville-Eddy ISD.
 - Must be able to work effectively with other law enforcement and non-law enforcement personnel during periods of high, medium, and low stress situations.
 - Must be able to perform law enforcement job functions during emergency situations, inclement weather, and other unsafe conditions.
 - Must have the ability to maintain the highest personal and professional standards.
 - Must be able to conduct investigations, field interviews, and police interrogations.
 - Must be able to perform to required standards in conformance with the rules, standard operating procedures, and policies of the Bruceville-Eddy Police Department.
 - Must possess comprehensive knowledge of and ability to interpret Texas Statutes, federal laws, and local ordinances.
 - Must have the ability to write reports and use computers.
 - Must meet all TCOLE Peace Officer Requirements.
- **All applicants are required to complete the Personal History Statement form AND release of information form available on the TCOLE website.** You may submit your resume, personal history statement and release of information form via email to mdorsey@bruceville-eddy.us.
