Minimum Qualifications

- Must be at least 21 years of age.
- Must be a United States Citizen.
- Must be a High School Graduate or Possess a GED Equivalent.
- Must be in Excellent Physical and Mental Health and Free of any Drug Dependency or Illegal Drug Use (A Drug Screen, Physical and Psychological Examination are required prior to appointment).
- Must be free of any Criminal Record (Above the grade of Class "C" Misdemeanor).
- Must Possess a Valid Texas Driver's License.
- Must have Reliable Transportation.
- Must be Willing and Able to Work Shift Work, which may include weekends and holidays.

Applicant must hold at minimum a T.C.O.L.E. Basic Peace Officers License. Applicants will be screened, and subjected to a complete background investigation. Selected applicants will be notified for interview. No information will be disclosed before or during the screening process. No resumes will be accepted at this time, only initial personal history statement application.

All interested and qualified individuals may apply in person at the Sheriff's Office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, until such time as position has been filled.
