Job Description

Under general supervision, is responsible for answering 911 emergency calls and assisting citizens in obtaining emergency services. Responsible for performing technical and administrative radio communications involving the deployment of police, fire, and EMS personnel according to request for service and available manpower.

Work involves the operation of telephone equipment and computer terminals in the Police Department. Must be able to type 30 words per minute with 90% accuracy.

Expedited hiring process for applicants with a valid TCOLE Telecommunications Officer license and a minimum of two years of full time, paid, dispatching experience. Communication Officers with intermediate or higher certification, bilingual in Spanish, and/or other special skills or certifications are preferred, but we will train the right person, even if you don't have any prior experience.

Applicants must have a valid Texas driver's license, and pass a physical examination including a drug screen.
