**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Provides police protection and security for the general public.
- Provides law enforcement support to the airlines, vendors, tenants, passengers, and TSA passenger screening operations.
- Controls and directs traffic and issues city ordinance violations, parking and traffic citations, and misdemeanor citations.
- Initiates arrests, when appropriate, in response to Federal, State, and local laws and city ordinances.
- Responds to all emergency situations.
- Investigates traffic accidents, fire, burglary, robbery alarms, and security door alarms.
- Prepares and submits required reports on incidents, accidents, and offenses.
- Patrolling the area and monitoring activities at the airport and its terminals may require standing, walking, twisting, kneeling, and may require running, handling a firearm and modern police equipment in response to emergencies.
- Performs related duties and fulfills responsibilities as required.
