What we provide:

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be a United States Citizen
- Must be 21 years of age or upon graduating the police academy
- High School/GED required
- No Felony or Class A misdemeanor convictions; no Class B misdemeanor convictions within the past (10) years.
- Valid driver's license
- Veterans must have an Honorable Discharge

The pay structure as follows:

Recruit Pay:

\$21.00 per hour, with benefits while in the academy.

*If currently enrolled in the academy, upon hire you would be paid throughout the remainder of the academy. *

\$22.00 per hour, upon completion of the academy and meeting state license as a peace officer or currently Texas certified officer. *pay is based on 2184 annual hours*

\$23.00 per hour, upon completion of one year probation period.

Certified Officer:

\$22.00 per hour, upon the start of FTO.

\$23.00 per hour, upon completion of one year probation period (\$50,232 annually).

pay is based on 2184 annual hours
