5. Discuss and take action to establish an advisory committee to provide recommendations related to the reporting of motor vehicle stop data ("racial profiling reports") under Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 2B.0054-2B.0055.
6. Discuss and take action to establish an advisory committee to provide recommendations related to the creation of a polygrapher proficiency certificate and rules and model policy for the use of polygraphs by law enforcement agencies.
7. Discuss and take action on timelines and offense levels for waiver eligibility under TCOLE Rule 211.30, Chief Administrator Responsibilities for Class A and B Waivers.
8. Discuss and take action on exceptions and exemptions for Class A and B misdemeanor disqualifying offenses under TCOLE Rule 217.1, Minimum Standards for Enrollment and Initial Licensure.
9. Receive public comment on any topic, without action.
10. Executive Session to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers, and personnel issues, including evaluation of Executive Director's job performance pursuant to Sections 551.071 and .074 of the Texas Government Code, Open Meetings Act.
