# TEXAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT

## Quarterly Meeting Minutes March 3, 2016

On Thursday, March 3, 2016, at 9:30 a.m., the quarterly meeting of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) was held at the J.J. Pickle Research Campus, The Commons Learning Center, 10100 Burnet Road, Bldg 137, Austin, Texas.

Commissioners attending were Sheriff Joel W. Richardson, Presiding Officer; Ms. Patt Scheckel-Hollingsworth, Assistant Presiding Officer; Major Jason Hester, Secretary; Ms. Patricia Burruss; Constable Ron Hood; Mr. James Oakley; Senior Police Officer Joe Pennington; and Chief Ruben Villegas. Commissioner Rob Kyker was absent.

Raymond Winter and Veena Mohan represented the Office of the Attorney General. ### **Agenda item #1, Call to order**

Presiding Officer Richardson called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. The presentation of colors was by the Belton Police Department Honor Guard members Raul Montes, Candace Hawkins, Joshua Koontz, and Richard Kusak. Commissioner Villegas led the pledge of allegiance and Commissioner Hester gave the invocation. Roll was called and a quorum was present.

### **Agenda item #2, Approval of the minutes of the December 3, 2015, quarterly commission meeting at Austin, Texas.**

Commissioner Hester made a motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Burruss seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda item #3, Receive reports. Take action if necessary.**

- **Presiding Officer's Report**

Presiding Officer Richardson thanked the Commission, staff, hosts, and participants of the regional meetings that occurred in January and February. The Commission used information gathered at these meetings to formulate a strategic plan outline to serve the agency for the next two years.

Special guests Tim Rutland, Executive Director, Texas Commission on Fire Protection and Paul Maldonado, Compliance Manager, were introduced and welcomed.

- **Executive Director's Report**

Executive Director Vickers introduced two new TCOLE employees. Reynaldo "Rey" Olvera began his 22 year law enforcement career with the La Joya Police Department and recently retired from the Mission Police Department. He holds a Master Peace Officer Certificate and holds a complete FBI clearance which he has held for the past eight years. Rey is an Investigator with the Enforcement Division.

Mike Dickey began his 44 year law enforcement career with the Alvin Police Department before entering the U.S. Air Force serving in security and investigative roles and retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel. Most recently, Mike was with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office where he served as Deputy Chief. He is a Training Academy and Contract Evaluator with the Field Services Division.

Mr. Vickers noted that during the Tour of Texas, commissioners and staff visited eight cities where regional meetings were held and input was gathered from our stakeholders.

Commissioner Villegas asked for the actions the commission takes upon receipt of a notice of arrest. Mr. Vickers stated that first, we open an investigation; second, we prioritize based on type of arrest, i.e. minor, felony, or offense involving family violence or line of duty; third, we follow through the adjudication where we then take action.

Commissioner Hester noted that on the criminal misconduct list, 50% of the peace officer licensees on the list were not currently working when arrested.

- Operations Director's Report

Director Helenberg said that since we started accepting training provider applications again, Brownsville Police Department has been awarded a training provider contract and an application from Tarrant County 911 is pending approval. Several other applications have been received and are in the review process. Commissioner Hester asked that a list of approved training providers and academies be included in each Executive Director's Report.

We are completing the disciplinary actions on non-compliance for the 2013 – 2015 training unit.

- Government Relations Director's Report

Director Grigsby noted that there is on-going dialogue with members and stakeholders as we implement bills and prepare seven new curriculum. Currently, there are two legislative hearings in March that we will provide input for: the House Committee on Emerging Issues in Texas Law Enforcement which includes body cameras and the implementation of that program, and Senate Criminal Justice that will be focusing on mental health issues.

Commissioner Burruss made a motion to accept the three staff reports. Commissioner Hester seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda item #4, Take action to enroll and induct officers in the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial Monument. Waive the requirement for induction at a separate Commission meeting, and take action to induct officers into the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial Monument who were enrolled today.**

Ken Mobley announced that there has been one line of duty death since the December 2015 meeting.

Officer David S. Hofer, Euless Police Department, EOW Tuesday, March 1, 2016.

Mr. Mobley read the names of those to be enrolled and inducted in the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial Monument.

Commissioner Oakley made a motion to approve agenda item 4. Commissioner Villegas seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda item #5, Discuss and take action to approve the recommendations for the 2015 Law Enforcement Achievement Awards.**

Mr. Vickers asked the commissioners to review the names of the nominees that are being recommended for the award. He noted that the names need to remain confidential until all applicants have been notified. The 2016 judges were thanked for their time and consideration in selecting this year's recipients. The judges are: Deputy Assistant Director J. Frank Woodall, Texas Department of Public Safety; Chief Danny Presley, Webster Police Department; Sheriff Don Sowell, Grimes County Sheriff's Office; Constable Rick Coffman, Williamson County Constable Pct. 2; Chief Jimmy Ellison, Abilene Christian University Police Department. The presentation ceremony will be on Friday, June 24, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. at the Capitol Auditorium with a reception immediately following.

Commissioner Oakley made a motion to approve agenda item 5. Commissioners Hollingsworth and Burruss seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda item #6, Discuss and take action on proposed orders of amendments to existing TCOLE rules.**

General Counsel John Beauchamp explained that there are three proposed amendments for consideration. Proposed amendment 1 and 2 remove obsolete numbering. Proposed amendment 3 removes the requirement of serving civil process for three years. This amendment is based on input the agency has received regarding allowing civilians who have served civil process to receive the proficiency certificate.

- Proposed Amendment 1  
§225.1 Issuance of a Jailer License through a Contract Jail Facility (amend)
- Proposed Amendment 2  
§225.3 Issuance of Peace Officer License through a Medical Corporation (amend)
- Proposed Amendment 3  
§221.25 Civil Process Proficiency (amend)

Commissioner Oakley made a motion to approve all three amendments. Presiding Officer Richardson noted that two individuals have asked to make comments concerning amendment 3.

Delton Thrasher and Todd Tiemann addressed the commission as representatives of the Justice of the Peace and Constables Association, Education Committee, concerning proposed amendment 3. Constable Thrasher spoke in favor of the proposal noting that allowing court clerks to qualify for the Civil Process Proficiency would enhance their proficiency and professionalism with a certification they can aspire to. They currently train like sheriff and constable's deputies, attend the same school, but they cannot qualify for the same certificate. Holding the certificate does not give the authority to serve civil process. Chief Deputy Tiemann supported Constable Thrasher's comments. Commissioner Hood appreciated this being brought to his attention as he believes the clerks need to be recognized for their hard work.

Discussion ensued to narrow the intent of the rule so Subsection (1)(a) of rule 221.25 will read, "at least three years full-time experience in a constable or sheriff's office working with civil process;"

Commissioner Oakley amended his motion to approve all three proposed amendments and to accept the amended language to proposal 3. Commissioner Hester seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda item #7, Discuss and take action on final orders of amendments to existing and new TCOLE rules.**

Mr. Beauchamp stated this final amendment was approved for proposal at the September 2015 quarterly meeting and was posted in the Texas Register. There were no public comments concerning this amendment.

Commissioner Oakley made a motion to approve the final amendment. Commissioner Hollingsworth seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Chacon was convicted of a Class A misdemeanor, Driving While Intoxicated. The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) recommended suspension of the license for five (5) years with two (2) years enforced and three (3) years probated. The Executive Director filed exceptions and recommended a ten (10) year suspension with five (5) years enforced and five (5) years probated.

Nadia Stewart with the Combined Law Enforcement Associations of Texas (CLEAT) spoke on Mr. Chacon's behalf asking that the Commission follow the recommendation of the ALJ, with the suspension to begin at the time that the proposal for decision was issued.

Commissioner Hollingsworth made a motion to decline the ALJ's sanction and instead adopt the Executive Director's recommendation to suspend the license of Jesus Chacon for ten (10) years with the first five (5) years enforced and the remaining five (5) years probated, and that it begin the date when the suspension is signed. Commissioner Hester seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
