JOB SUMMARY:

The Galveston County Sheriff's Office is seeking a dedicated and qualified individual to serve as a Corporal in the Patrol Division. This position is responsible for supervising Patrol Division staff, performing preventive patrols in assigned areas, making public presentations, conducting interviews of victims, witnesses, suspects, and making arrests when appropriate.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- **Physical Fitness:**
 - Ability to meet the physical demands of the position, measured by a 500-meter row, Pass or Fail (1:53 Male / 2:12 Female). Applicant will be allowed two attempts but both must be completed during the same row assessment.
- **Certification and Qualifications:**
 - Possess a valid Texas driver's license.
 - Hold an Intermediate Peace Officer certification (or higher) through TCOLE.
 - Must be currently and successfully qualified with a duty firearm.
 - Field Training Officer (FTO) certified with relevant training experience.
 - A minimum of four years of experience in law enforcement
- **Knowledge and Experience:**
 - In-depth understanding of Patrol level operations.
 - Knowledge of the criminal justice system and court procedures.
 - Familiarity with the policies and procedures of the Galveston County Sheriff's Office.
 - Proficiency in records management systems such as Moblan, OSSI (RMS), and other related systems.
 - Experience with time management and payroll systems.
- **Communication Skills:**
 - Ability to articulate clear and complete detailed reports, both criminal and administrative. Must have the ability to communicate clearly and effectively with the public.
- **On-Call Readiness:**
 - Must be able to respond promptly when on-call and be available via phone and email during non-traditional hours (nights, weekends, and holidays).
- **Adaptability:**
 - Ability to work under adverse conditions and during irregular hours, including nights, weekends, holidays, and overtime.
- **Testing & Review:**
 - Successful completion of a background review and interview board.
 - 500-meter row test.
