One person arrested in Milam County for Tampering with Government Record

Chief James O. Blackmon was arrested by investigators from the Enforcement Division of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards & Education (TCLEOSE) on Thursday (07/05/2012) at the Buckholts Police Department on charges of Tampering with a Government Record. The charges stem from an investigation into the appointments and pay status of officers appointed by Blackmon to the Police Department.
