



Position: **Director of Regional Law Enforcement Academy**

The **Capital Area Council of Governments**, a regional agency serving ten Central Texas counties, is seeking candidates for its Director of the Regional Law Enforcement Academy (RLEA). The academy conducts Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) mandated training courses including Basic Peace Officer Courses and works with local law enforcement agencies to identify other training needs. Candidates should have experience developing lessons plans, delivering a variety of types of training, working knowledge of TCOLE academic requirements, and should have experience with budget management, use of social media, and general administrative work. CAPCOG provides paid medical, dental, and vision and provides a 401K contribution of 8% for all employees, and flexible work hours to support training schedules.

Education

Required: Bachelor's degree from accredited college/university with major coursework in criminal justice, public administration, or a related field.

Experience

Required: Minimum of 8 years of experience in law enforcement including the development and delivery of training in accordance with TCOLE licensing requirements. Must have master peace officer and instructor certification by TCOLE. Minimum of three years in general administrative management duties in a government agency including work with contracts, budget, and grants.

Preferred: Experience working with both city and county law enforcement agencies.

Experience and education may be substituted for one another.

Salary range: \$84,000 - \$92,000 depending on qualifications.
