The Clay County Sheriff's Office serves more than 1100 square miles of northern Texas. Clay County borders Wichita, Archer, Montague, and Jack counties to its' west, east and south and Oklahoma to its' north. The Clay County Sheriff's Office is a rural agency and is staffed for 12 Patrol Deputies, dispatch and jail staff, administrative clerks, investigators, one Chief Deputy and the elected Sheriff. This selection process for this position opens in October of 2020 and remains open until filled.

STARTING PAY: Base pay of 41k-43k, depending on experience.

REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 21 years of age
- Be a citizen of the United States
- Possess a High School Diploma or equivalent
- Possess a valid state driver's license
- Possess Peace Officer TCOLE license
- Ability to work various shifts, weekends, and holidays
- Ability to walk, run, climb, or crawl in the pursuit of suspects; to work outdoors in inclement weather and extreme temperatures.
- Candidates will be expected to participate in and pass a medical examination including drug testing.
- Live within Clay County or within 20 air miles of CCSO to participate in take home car program.

BENEFITS & PERKS:

- Longevity Pay after completion of one year of service
- Vacation/sick leave accrual starting in the first month.
- Holidays as designated by the Commissioner's Court.
- FREE employee medical, dental, vision and life insurance
- Take home outfitted Tahoe (residency requirement)
- 12 hour shifts with every other weekend off
- Uniforms and equipment, including vest, sidearm, rifle, shotgun, and leather gear.
- Certificate pay for all post-basic TCOLE certifications.
