SALARY: \$48,500.00 Annually Salary

Paid Time Off: PTO accrual begins immediately at 8 hrs. per month. Eligible for use after first Six months (1 Week) then (2Week) after probationary period ends.

EDUCATION & CERTIFICATIONS:

Applicant must have a High School Diploma or GED Certificate. Applicant must possess a valid Texas driver's license. Must be able to communicate the English language both in writing and verbally.

GENERAL:

Applicants must have knowledge of the Laws of the State of Texas as well as Federal Laws, Basic TCOLE Certificate, or TCOLE Certification as a Licensed Peace Officer, and must qualify annually with assigned firearms. Must be physically fit and able to lift and move as the job requires. Applicant must be able to pass a drug test, be at least 18 years of age. Individuals must have a clear criminal history and be able to work shift work. **TEXAS BASIC PEACE OFFICER** certification and currently licensed by the **TEXAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT (TCOLE)**. Preference will also be given to applicants currently enrolled in a Basic Peace Officer Academy within 90 days of scheduled graduation at the time of the entrance examination.

DUTIES & REQUIREMENTS:

Work 12-hour shifts depending on assignment; some duties include routine patrol, responsibilities of controlling traffic and enforcing all traffic laws, prevention vandalism, theft, and damage to property, and to protect human life, etc. The employees will work independently using personal discretion and judgment in a wide range of circumstances which may arise.

PATROL FIELD TRAINING PROGRAM:

All Patrol Deputies are required to complete sixteen weeks of field training which is based upon the officer's training progression and experience.
