Description

The City of Dalhart, Texas is accepting applications for a full-time TCOLE certified Peace Officer.

Depending upon experience, officers will be assigned to FTO training 12 to 16 weeks in length. Officers work 12 hour shifts and have every other weekend off. Assigned duties will include answering calls for service, crash investigations, traffic enforcement, narcotics investigations and assisting the Criminal Investigations Division when needed.

Every six months officers rotate to another shift, be it days or nights. Officers will work in varying climates that the Panhandle of Texas offers. Temperatures in the winter months can drop into the single digits and in the summer months temperatures can reach above 100 dgrs.

The City of Dalhart, along with the Dallam County Sheriff's Office and Hartley County Sheriff's office have joined with Frank Phillips College and formed a local training coalition to meet the training needs of all officers.
