The Oak Ridge North Police Department is currently accepting resumes for the position of Police Officer. The Department serves the City of Oak Ridge North 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The Police Department is comprised of 1 Chief, 1 Patrol Lieutenant, 1 Administrative Lieutenant, 1 Detective Sergeant, 1 Administrative Sr. Officer, 2 Patrol Sergeants, 1 Environmental Sergeant and 8 Patrol Officers.

Applicants must be TCOLE certified as a Texas Peace Officer from an accredited Law Enforcement Academy in Texas. Applicants must also possess a valid Texas Driver's License, must be 21 years of age or older, high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate, a United States citizen, an Honorable Discharge from the U.S. Armed Service if applicable, and must have vision correctable to 20/20. Any applicant must not have been convicted of a felony at any time or a Class B misdemeanor or above in the last 10 years.

Applicants will be required to pass all phases of a Physical Agility Test to continue in the hiring process. Upon successfully passing the P.A.T., applicants will be given a Psychological Exam, Oral Interview Board, Medical Exam, Drug Screen, and a Background Check.

Starting pay for an Oak Ridge North Police Officer is \$57,915 annually. Additional pay is awarded depending on qualifications, TCOLE certifications, college credits, and prior service.

Job Description:

1. Provide for public safety by maintaining order, responding to emergencies, protecting people and property, enforcing motor vehicle and criminal laws, and promoting good community relations.
2. Identify, pursue, and arrest suspects and perpetrators of criminal acts.
3. Prepare reports that document incidents, activities, and accidents.
4. Patrol Officers are assigned to 12-hour shifts.
