The successful candidate will be the senior officer of the Spur Police Department. The mission of the Chief of Police is to ensure that the department protects the citizens' lives, property and peaceful enjoyment of the city in accordance with applicable local/state/federal law.

The Chief of Police deals with a wide variety of sensitive matters and must exercise exceptional decorum, resourcefulness and discretion in the performance of his/her duties. The Chief also serves as the primary point of contact for civil emergencies such as fires, major accidents, riots and incidents of civil unrest.

The Chief of Police is also responsible for all administrative functions within the police department. These include, but are not limited to: Writing all necessary reports and requests to appropriate governmental bodies/officials, staffing and personnel management, budgeting, appropriation of funds, fiscal management, etc.

The Chief of Police must live within the city limits of Spur. Salary is \$36,000 per annum.

Applicants will be asked to sign an F5R waiver. TCOLE Intermediate is preferred.

The Police Chief will have an annual performance review with the mayor of the city.
