The Town of Fulton is accepting applications for a Police Officer.

Fulton is a small, coastal town, off the Gulf of Mexico, located in Aransas County. To the south, the city of Fulton is bordered by Rockport, the county seat. Corpus Christi is approximately 32 miles to the southwest and Port Lavaca is 49 miles to the northeast. Fulton is most well known for being the home of Oysterfest, which occurs annually in March; however, there is a great deal more to offer. Fulton and Aransas County offers an excellent lifestyle, complete with a multitude of family friendly activities – indoor and out, beautifully relaxing coastal scenery, highly rated schools, and great restaurants. City employees also enjoy free access to the Fulton Pier, highly recognized for great fishing.

The Fulton PD is presently a small department, comprised of a working Chief and one officer, but is in the process of modernization, as well as expansion in the near future. Fulton is primarily a retirement/vacation town. As such, the population and call volume will fluctuate, depending on the seasons, events, and holidays. When officers are off duty or unavailable, the Town of Fulton utilizes contracts with the Rockport Police Department for additional coverage.

While the Town of Fulton may primarily be a retirement community, the PD does not have a 'retired-on duty mindset'. The Chief and Officers are expected to be actively policing within the community, treating everyone as fairly as possible, and going above and beyond, in all scenarios that arise. In addition, all city employees are expected to conduct themselves appropriately, whether on or off duty.

## **Shifts, Salary, and Benefits:**

Work weeks are 40 hours, comprised of 4, consecutive, 10-hour shifts, followed by 3 days off. All Fulton Police Officers are to conduct their own investigations and see cases, from beginning to end, in a timely manner. Schedules are flexible and will be determined by seasons, holidays, events, etc.. Hours can also be flexible to accommodate the officer's personal life, as well as trainings. To advance in certification and stay up to date with continuing education, officers are encouraged to attend and/or complete online trainings. Salary is between \$48,000 - \$52,000 annually, dependent upon experience and certification. Locally, there are plenty of opportunities for off duty security. Officers can utilize the Texas Municipal Retirement System and Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas health coverage.

## **Equipment:**

Officers will be provided with department issued uniforms, pistol, and rifle, as well as a fitted vest. Please note, due to fitting, there will be a delay in the issuance of the vest. A take home unit is available, depending on distance of travel.
