Position: Full Time Deputy

Open: Until filled

Current Salary: \$16.85 hr - \$19.25 hr DOQ

Schedule: 12 hr shifts, off every other weekend off.

Benefits: Take home car, Insurance/Medical paid by the county for the employee. Department furnishes ballistic vest, handgun, shotgun, and patrol rifle. Employee receives uniform stipend of \$400 annually.

MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS:

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

High school diploma or equivalent is required. The individual must possess a minimum basic TCOLE peace officer license. A minimum of one (1) year of experience in law enforcement is desirable.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS

Other specialized job requirements include a valid Texas Driver's License and a basic Law Enforcement Certification with the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE). Must be able to meet TCOLE and Department requirements for psychological and medical examinations.

DESIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

LANGUAGE SKILLS

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine, reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of organization.

REASONING ABILITY

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form. Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations.
