MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS:

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE:

High school diploma or equivalent required; must possess a minimum basic TCOLE peace officer license; a minimum of one (1) year of experience in law enforcement is desirable. Must be willing to re-locate to Swisher County within on year of hire date.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS:

Other specialized job requirements include a valid Texas Driver's License and a basic Law Enforcement Certification with the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE); must be able to meet TCOLE and Department requirements for psychological and medical examinations.

DESIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATION:

LANGUAGE SKILLS:

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions and procedure manuals; ability to write routine reports and correspondence; ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of organization.

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form; ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations.
