Position: Police Sergeant

The Denton County Water District currently has an opening for the position of Police Sergeant. If you are a service-minded individual who believes in community policing, being a leader while supervising and mentoring others, we would like to speak with you. Denton County Water District Police Department is a full-service municipal style police department within northern Denton County that serves a population of over 15,000 residents who reside in the communities of Savannah, Artesia, and Arrowbrooke within Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 10. The purpose of this position is to protect and serve the citizens of the District. This is accomplished by supervising the activities of police personnel. Other duties may include monitoring police reports, overseeing complaints, answering calls for service, and interfacing with other District employees and citizens.

REQUIREMENTS

Formal Education / Knowledge

- High School Diploma or G.E.D. and a minimum of thirty (30) college credit hours from an accredited college or university. OR:
- High School Diploma or G.E.D. and a minimum of five (5) years of active military service with one (1) year at the rank of Corporal (E4) or higher.

EXPERIENCE

- Candidates must have six (6) years of law enforcement experience with a medium or large-sized department with one (1) year of management experience at the rank of Police Sergeant, or above and;
- Completion of either ILEA School of Supervision (month-long course) or Bill Blackwood's Law Enforcement Management Institute (LEMIT) Leadership Command College or comparable accredited law enforcement school of leadership and supervision.

CERTIFICATION AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Valid Texas Class C Driver's License
- TCOLE Peace Officer License
- TCOLE Intermediate Peace Officer Proficiency Certificate

PREFERRED CERTIFICATION AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- TCOLE Advanced Peace Officer Proficiency Certificate
- Sixty (60) college credit hours from an accredited college or university, or more.
