The UTA Police Department is seeking exceptionally qualified applicants for the position of:

POLICE SERGEANT

Responsible for supervising police personnel engaged in law enforcement duties associated with the protection, safety, and welfare of students, employees, visitors, and property within the area under the control and jurisdiction of The University of Texas System. Exercises independent judgment within limits prescribed by law, Rules and Regulations of the Board of Regents, institutional rules and regulations and Director of Police departmental policies and procedures. Serves as a Campus Security Authority as defined by the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act).

COMPENSATION/BENEFITS

Salary Range: \$63,264 to \$78,600 DOQ. Vacation and Sick Leave accrued at eight hours per month. Fourteen paid holidays were authorized 2015-16 fiscal year. Eight hour shifts with shift differential pay of \$130 monthly for 2nd and 3rd shifts. All equipment, including weapon, is furnished. Benefits package including medical, dental, vision, pre-tax flexible spending, and supplemental life insurance offered. Retirement is through Teacher Retirement System. Supplemental retirement and disability insurance plans also offered. Specific benefit details available on request. **100% tuition reimbursement available after 1 year of service** (some stipulations apply).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Sixty college hours credit or an Associate's degree from an accredited institution. Must successfully pass an approved promotional examination administered by the UT System Director of Police, or designee. Must possess an Intermediate Certification from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) at the time the promotional examination is taken, or have met all the requirements for the Intermediate Certification but not in receipt of the certificate at the time the promotional examination is taken. Three years' experience as a full time, commissioned police officer. A valid driver's license not subject to suspension.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

Employed as a current Sergeant with any University of Texas System component or on the current UT System Police promotional list for this position. Instructor Certification through TCOLE. Four years of experience as a commissioned police officer, which includes at least two years of experience as a commissioned police sergeant.
