



The Amarillo Police Department will be conducting a Basic Police Academy Civil Service Entrance Exam on Saturday, November 5th, 2016. The 91st Academy is scheduled to begin in June, 2017.

The deadline to have your application turned in is Friday, October 28th, 2016 at 5:00 PM.

The Amarillo Police Department offers excellent pay and benefits. Starting salary for a police recruit in the academy is \$46,863/year. After 4 years the officer's salary is \$63,468/year. The City also pays certificate pay, education pay and shift differential pay to officers. The City pays a portion of the premiums for health insurance. Employees and family who are covered by City health insurance can use the free City Clinic.

Officers accumulate 15 days of sick leave per year and they receive 15 days of vacation per year for the first 6 years. Additional vacation is accumulated after the first 6 years. Officers also receive 8 paid holidays per year.
