Other responsibilities include conducting police investigations, enforcing state and local traffic laws, identify and issue citations, prepare reports, perform jailer duties, provide emergency first aid and other duties as assigned.

The **Highland Village Police Department (HVPD)** is a full service department with public safety dispatch and local jail services. There are 31 full-time sworn police officers.
